

APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION IN HPS STUD BOOK

The application form for the registration of Highland pony youngstock which is suitable for registrations in the main body of the Stud Book, all appendices and the Part Bred Register must be completed and sent to the Society with the £20 registration fee (£40 for registrations after 30 November in the year of birth.) Please note the following important points when submitting the form.

- 1 Both sides must be fully completed. The outline diagram **MUST** have all the whorls, markings etc clearly marked. The narrative below the diagram **MUST** describe all whorls and markings clearly and the form **MUST** be signed and dated. The microchip bar code label affixed above the breeder/inspector's signature. The Highland Pony Society is the issuing authority and will sign below the inspector's signature. The Stud Book number and Stallion Licence number of the sire will be added by the Society when issued.
- 2 The Stallion Service Certificate must accompany the form. It is the responsibility of the mare owner to make sure that this certificate has been obtained before the registration is applied for. If the stallion is owned by the breeder, there is no need to attach a Stallion Service Certificate.
- 3 The applicant **MUST** be the registered owner of the mare at the time of foaling.
- 4 The relevant registration fee must accompany the form.
- 5 The closing date for applications is 30 November. Late registrations will be charged at double the standard fee.
